

Are you looking for an adult *Sunday School class*? This is a great opportunity to start on the "ground floor" of a new class facilitated by Randy Hardy. Join us for this new beginning on **Sunday, September 8 at 9:30 AM!**

The Call: The Life and Message of The Apostle Paul - Wednesdays, 6:30-7:25 PM - Begins September 11 Join Rev. Craig Hutto for these interesting and historical studies that follow his sermon series. What would lead a first-century rabbi to travel thousands of miles by sea and land, to be beaten, imprisoned and ultimately beheaded for his faith? It was a call — a call to turn the world upside down. This is the story of the Apostle Paul, whose writings continue to shape the lives of one-third of the worlds' population, a man second only to Jesus in his impact and influence on the Christian faith, and whose witness defines what it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ, by author Adam Hamilton.
