Notes for Holy Communion

We offer three stations where you can receive Communion.

Two at the front chancel and one in the balcony.

Who can participate

In the United Methodist Church, everyone is welcome at the Lord's Table. Christ is the host, and all are invited. Whether this is your first time visiting, you're unsure of what you believe, you're still figuring things out, or you are an adult or a child, you are welcome to take part. Communion is one of our holy sacraments and a means of grace, a way God reminds us of His love for us and meets us right where we are.

Know that you are welcome here!

How it works

Follow the ushers to one of our three communion stations, where you'll receive a piece of bread and a cup of grape juice. Gluten-free bread is available; simply ask for it as you approach one of the stations. After receiving the elements, you're welcome to pause at the chancel to pray or return to your seat. You can leave your communion cup in the recessed cup holders in the communion railing. While others are receiving, you're invited to sing along with the hymns, pray silently, or spend time in quiet reflection. Today, you can leave your communion offering at the altar railing for pastor's discretionary.
